Leadership Team

David Clary

President/Owner

David was working as a business consultant in 2017 when he saw an opportunity to provide skilled, on-demand labor to the utility solar industry, subsequently founding Ridgeline Renewables. The company enjoyed strong growth over the next several years, and in 2020 he launched Knight Construction, offering subcontracting for mechanical assembly and module installation. Since then, several more entities have been added under The Clary Group's umbrella: Hoplite Power, an electrical subcontracting company; and Hoplite Equipment, which provides task-specific machinery, along with skilled operators. TCG companies have enjoyed a rate of annual growth averaging over 80% year-over-year, with no sign of slowing down. By broadening offerings within the utility solar vertical, each new entity benefits from synergy with its existing sister organizations.

David is a Texas native and graduate of Texas A&M University, where he studied Industrial Distribution. Following college, he served for ten years in the U.S. Army, deploying to Honduras in 1990, and to the Middle East for Desert Storm in 1991. Later, he was stationed in South Korea near the DMZ, and wrapped up his career at Fort Campbell in Kentucky, serving with the 101st Airborne. Over the course of his military career, he served as an enlisted infantryman, an armored cavalry scout, and an intelligence officer. Entering the civilian world in 1998, he worked for fifteen years as a medical device business development specialist, advising interventional cardiologists, neurosurgeons, and orthopedic surgeons in the operating room. David left his corporate job in 2012 to strike out on his own, founding Medgrow Marketing and working as a business development consultant. By 2015, he had grown this expertise into a general business consultancy role with a diverse book of clients, when an opportunity inspired him to double down on the solar industry in a construction services capacity. A decade later, The Clary Group and its subsidiaries boast broad capabilities across the utility solar vertical and can handle even the most ambitious projects.

David lives in Houston, Texas, occasionally traveling to enjoy outdoor pursuits, particularly sportfishing, skiing, and mountaineering.
